Please note, each club is limited to a certain number of pupils that can attend which is highlighted in the table above. To apply for a space for your child to attend any of the clubs on offer, please complete the online form as soon as possible.

Additionally, due to the limited spaces of each club, we will be asking Parents/Carers to read and agree to the following points when applying for a space in a club for your child:

- 1. Your child will attend the club each week. Due to the high demand for places, should your child not attend two consecutive sessions, their allocated space for that club will be given to another child.
- 2. You will ensure that your child has the correct kit/resources required to attend the club. Should your child attend their club without the relevant kit/resources for two consecutive weeks, their allocated space for that club will be given to another child.
- 3. Should your child's behaviour become an issue during the club they are attending, their allocated space for that club will be given to another child.
- 4. If you are collecting your child, you will do so from the required collection point at the time given.

The closing date for all submissions is **Friday 20**th **September.** If your child is successful in obtaining a space in their chosen club, you will be notified by the club leader via email on **Monday 23**rd **September.**

If your child is successful in gaining a space for Drawing or Singing Club we will make sure you are contacted on Monday 23 by 8am. This is because these clubs start on Monday 23rd September at 3:30pm.
