This term, your child will be discussing the NSPCC's PANTS rules in our PSHE lessons. During these discussions, we aim to teach our children the following important safety skills without giving explicit information or telling scary stories. These are the PANTS rules:

P: Privates are privateA: Always remember your body belongs to youN: No means noT: Talk about secrets that upset you.S: Speak up, someone can help

The lessons empower children, in an age appropriate way, to recognise their rights to their own bodies, say no to touch that is unwanted, and tell someone if they feel uncomfortable. The lessons include activities which help children understand:

- Appropriate and inappropriate touching
- Their right to say no to things that make them feel upset or uncomfortable
- The names for parts of the body
- Who to turn to if they ever feel upset or worried
