We are asking children to come in wearing their PJs on Friday 17th May, as part of BookTrust's Pyjamarama fundraiser to help every child get a bedtime story.

Children at Oakwood are getting ready to wear their finest PJs and grab their favourite book as they make their way into school to take part in Pyjamarama, BookTrust's annual fundraising celebration.

Pupils have lots of activities to look forward to on the day, they can expect to enjoy a day of sharing stories helping them to get excited about the books they read and encouraging families to make sharing stories together a regular and long-lasting part of family life.

We are asking children to bring in £1 to donate to BookTrust and take part in Pyjamarama.

BookTrust is the UK's largest children's reading charity, and the money raised will be used to support children across the UK facing disadvantage, access books and reading support to ensure that every child gets a bedtime story.

- £1,000 could enable us to support 740 children with a disability that impacts motor skills, providing them with specially created touch and feel books, finger puppets and guidance for parents
