Attendance – what is the impact on outcomes?

In 2022

-59% of KS2 pupils in Plymouth met the expected standard in Reading Writing and Maths. Of which:
12% of pupils who had less than 90% attendance achieved expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths.
0.03% of pupils who had less than 50% attendance achieved expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths.

58.7% of pupils who had more than 90% attendance achieved a strong pass in English and Maths.30.7% of pupils who had less than 90% attendance achieved a strong pass in English and Maths.3% of pupils who had less than 50% attendance achieved a strong pass in English and Maths.
